## NMVTIS DISCLAIMER:

The National Motor Vehicle Title Information System (NMVTIS) is an electronic system that contains information on certain automobiles titled in the United States. NMVTIS is intended to serve as a reliable source of title and brand history for automobiles, but it does not contain detailed information regarding a vehicles repair history.

All states, insurance companies, and junk and salvage yards are bound by federal law to regularly report information to NMVTIS. However, NMVTIS does not contain information on all motor vehicles in the United States because some states are still not providing their vehicle data to the system.

Currently, the data provided to NMVTIS by the states is presented in a variety of time frames. While some states report and update NMVTIS data in real-time (as title transactions occur), other states send updates less frequently, such as once every 24 hours or within a period of days.

Information on previous, significant vehicle damage may not be in the system if the vehicle was never determined by an insurance company (or other appropriate entity) to be a "total loss" or branded by a state titling agency. Conversely, an insurance carrier may be made to report a "total loss" even if the vehicles titling-state has not determined the vehicle to be "salvage" or "junk."

Before making a decision to purchase a vehicle, consumers may wish to obtain an independent vehicle inspection, an NMVTIS Vehicle History Report, and consult other available vehicle information resources.

The information in NMVTIS includes:

Information from participating state motor vehicle titling agencies. Information on automobiles, buses, trucks, motorcycles, recreational vehicles, motor homes, and tractors. NMVTIS may not currently cover commercial vehicles if they are not in the state. Primary database for title records (in some states, those vehicles are managed by a separate state agency), although these records may be added at a later time.

Information on "brands" applied to vehicles provided by participating state motor vehicle titling agencies. Brand types and definitions vary by state but may provide useful information about the condition or prior use of the vehicle. Most recent odometer reading in the states title record.

Information from insurance companies and auto recyclers, including junk and salvage yards, that is by law to be reported to the system, beginning March 31, 2009. This information will if the vehicle was determined to be a "total loss" by an insurance carrier.

Information from junk and salvage yards receiving a "cash for clunker" vehicle traded-in under the Consumer Assistance to Recycle and Save Act of 2009 (CARS) Program.
